NOTE:

- The examinations in Elective Subjects (other than English and MIL) have been scheduled for two days. **Candidates will be examined strictly in the alphabetical order of the subjects offered** for each Part I, II & III. For example, in combination of **Economics/History**, the candidate should appear in **Economics** on the day of first Elective Subject (**16th May**) and in **History** on the day of second Elective Subject (**19th May**) of Part-I and so on for other parts. Similarly, in combination of **History/Political Science**, the examination in **History**, candidate should appear on the day of first Elective Subject (**1st May**) and in **Political Science**, on the day of second Elective Subject (**4th May**) of Part-II and similarly the candidate of Part-III will appear on (**22nd & 24th April**).
- However, since examinations in certain Elective subjects like **Arabic, Apparel Design Course, Advertising & Sales Management, Buddhist Studies, Computer Application, Commerce, Foreign Trade Practice & Procedure, Sales Promotion, Tax Procedure & Practice, Tourism & Travel Management** will be held only on one day, the candidates will be required to appear in the Second Elective Subject subsequent to the above examinations. For example, in combination of Economics/Tourism & Travel Management, the examination in Tourism & Travel Management will be held on the day of first Elective Subject and in Economics, on the day of second Elective subject of each Part.
- However, since examinations in certain Elective subjects like **French, German, Music and Spanish** will be held only on one day for each Part for example, the examination of said subjects for Part-I will be held on **21st May**, for Part-II on **8th May** and for Part-III on **27th April**, the candidates will be required to appear in the second Elective subject in other day of the Elective subjects examinations.
